

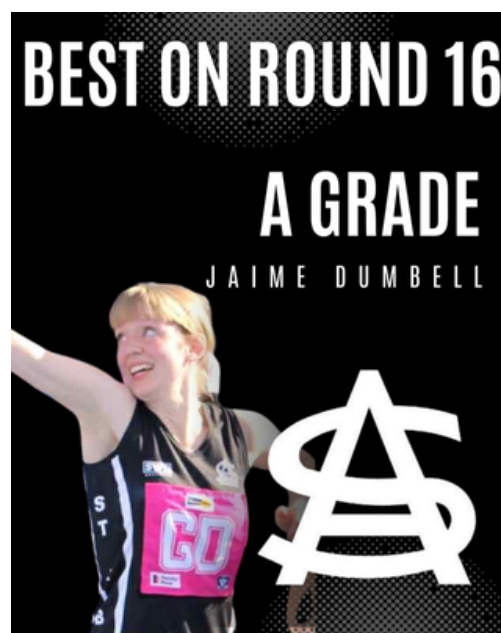
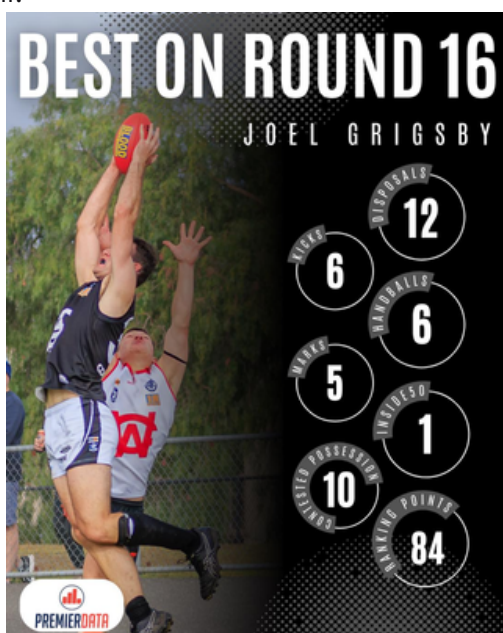

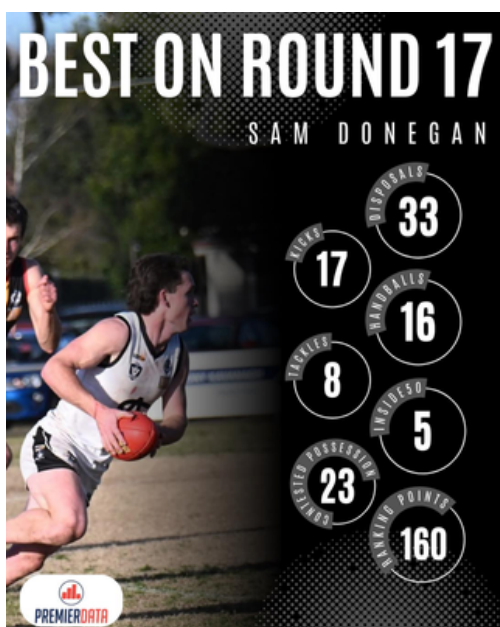

A big congratulations to Ross Wilson the Major Winner, Kye Warrin Runner Up & Tony Beardsell coming third on their well-deserved wins.

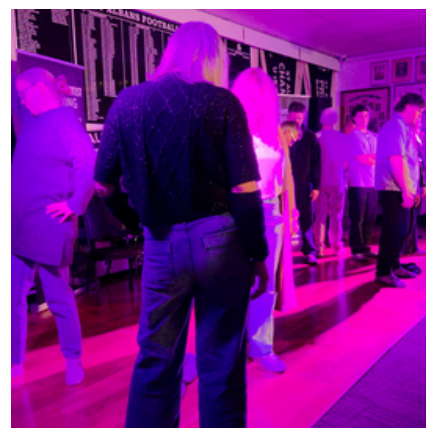

Opportunity changes game

For years, helping people has been such a big part of who I was, and who I want to be. So, with mental health having such a big impact on not only sports clubs, but schools, workplaces, and around the world, I knew that the Read the Play Game Changers was the perfect opportunity for me to help reduce the stigma and spread awareness about mental health across sporting communities.

In the Game Changers program, I helped create a race while actively with separate interlinking challenges that would help to bring body and netball clubs together and build teamwork across the sports teams while also tackling mental health in a fun team race.

There were four checkpoints for teams to work through to complete the Game Changers race. Those checkpoints were designed by myself and the three other Game Changers. Throughout this program I have been extremely lucky to have met many people. My three fellow Game Changers who I constructed the race with were: Shaya Walter, Noah Smith and Darcy Storrar. Together, we shared our ideas, gave constructive feedback, developed the Game Changers Race and had a blast getting to know each other along the way. Jess and Charney from Read the Play played a huge role in helping us bring our ideas to reality. Without them, the race would have purely been potential ideas but because of them we were able to make it happen. The range of viewpoints was helpful to look at the challenges from different perspectives and improve them from what each other said. I am extremely grateful to everyone that I worked with on this project and I extend my gratitude to Carly and Bethany from Cetus Media who helped us promote the race on social media.

Game Changers has also provided me with some other separate opportunities. There was the wellbeing session held with Mark Worthington from the Geelong Cats where we got a tour of GMHBA Stadium and got to hear him speak more in depth about his role and how we could utilise some of the things he does in our own lives. The fundraiser breakfast for Read the Play was where we first launched the Game Changers race and heard from the excellent Kath Kuschel. Those were just a few experiences that added onto everything I discovered throughout the program.

Now, with Game Changers nearing its end for the year, I have come out of it with so many positive benefits that I never would have received had I not joined the program. The experience of working with people of different ages, skills and vices has been a new one for me but a brilliant one.

As I have shared and educated others through the race, I have been able to further my knowledge and understanding on mental health which also enables me to be able to help others even more in the future.
