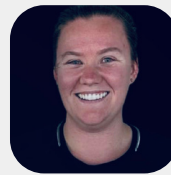

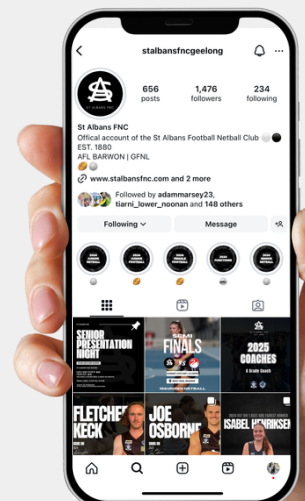

STAFNC Initiatives & Partnerships in 2024



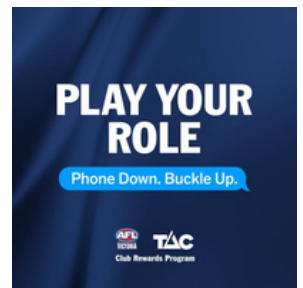
