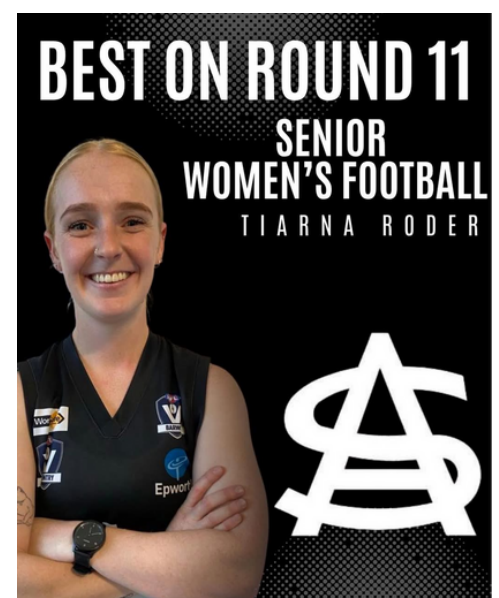
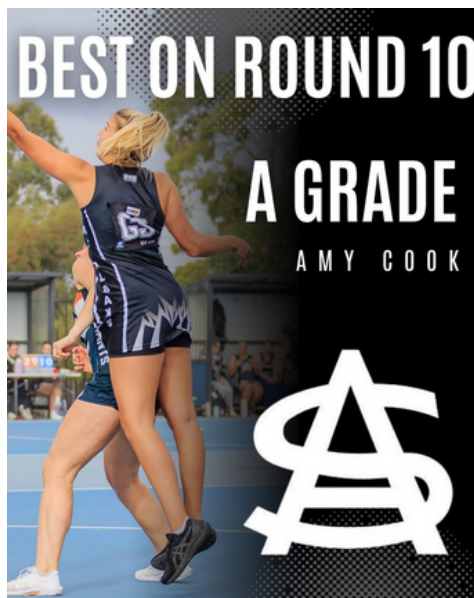
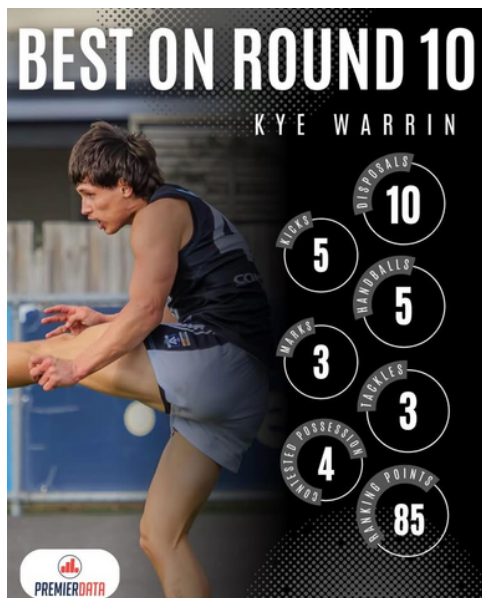
BEST ON FOR STAFNC ROUND 9

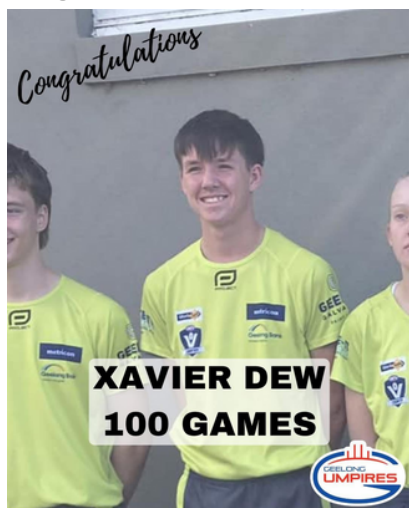

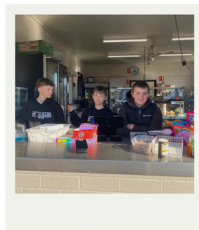

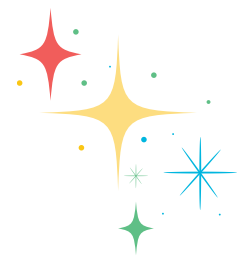

Read the Play

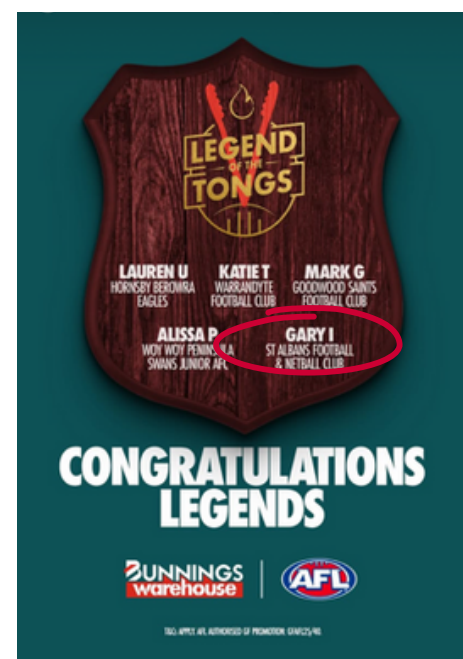
Read the Play delivers its program through partnerships with local sporting clubs by integrating mental health literacy and help-seeking education into the club environment. The program uses a team-based, interactive approach led by trained facilitators, involving discussions, activities, and games designed to engage young participants aged 12-18.

12-14 YEARS	 Hit the Mark	Hit the Mark aims to build emotional strength and understanding the risks of vaping. It emphasises peer support, critical thinking about advertising tactics, and practical skills for saying no and supporting friends.
	 Game Plan	Game Plan aims to encourage young people to build their teams on and off the sporting field. It discusses ways to support each other's choices, take risks safely, and the relationship between alcohol and mental health.
	 Huddle Up	Huddle up aims to increase knowledge on mental health, promote help seeking behaviour and influence beliefs and attitudes related to identifying and responding to peers who may be at risk of mental ill-health or cyber bullying.
	 MVP	MVP aims to increase knowledge on mental health, promote help seeking behavior and influence beliefs and attitudes related to identifying and responding to their peers who may be at risk of mental ill-health or suicide.
	 Play On	Play On aims to increase mental health literacy and knowledge of the impact underage alcohol use can have on mental health outcomes.
16-18 YEARS	 Take A Chance	Take a Chance aims to increase mental health literacy and knowledge of the impact that poor mental health can have on decision making and risk taking.
