Our Commitment

We promote Australian Rules Football and Netball in the Geelong Region, field competitive teams, and develop players for higher levels of competition.

Code of Conduct Statement

To ensure the personal development of individuals and the Club, this Code of Conduct is essential. STAFNC, along with AFL Barwon, does not condone behaviour that brings the Club or the game into disrepute. All members must uphold the Club's reputation in public and within our community.

Expected Conduct

All members, players, and staff must demonstrate:

- **Respect** for teammates, staff, volunteers, umpires, and the Club.
- **Excellence** in training, games, and administration.
- **Accountability** for actions and club commitments.
- **Camaraderie** by fostering teamwork and support.
- **Honesty** in all dealings.

Prohibited Conduct

STAFNC does not tolerate:

- Discrimination or racism
- Underage drinking or drug use
- Verbal abuse or physical violence
- Drunken behaviour

Breaches of this Code may result in disciplinary action, including suspension or expulsion.

Responsibilities

- **Administrative Staff:** Provide quality coaching, facilities, and support from junior to senior levels.
- **Players:** Develop skills, maintain fitness, show commitment, and give their best effort.
